Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) such as paint, pesticides, batteries, oils, cleaners, and other chemicals can be toxic to the environment if not properly disposed of. These items can pollute our lakes and waterways, and endanger our families, children, pets, and wildlife. If you have some HHW you wish to dispose of, we can help. Here's how to do it:

- ✓ Collect your Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) items
- ✓ Set them on your curb on **WEDNESDAY JAN. 12** and **THURSDAY JAN. 13, 2022**, between the hours of **9:00 am and 3:00 pm**.
- ✓ Our staff will pick it up for you to be properly disposed of.

**List of ACCEPTABLE and NON-ACCEPTABLE ITEMS**



These items ARE accepted in the HHW event:



- Batteries
- Paints
- Solvents
- Gasoline
- Pesticides
- Herbicides
- Pool chemicals
- Acids and Corrosives
- Sharps
- Artist supplies
- Antifreeze
- Toxic cleaners
- Fluorescent lights and CFLs
- Propane tanks (less than 5 gal)
- Prescription medication (non narcotic)
- Mercury thermometers
- Bleaches and dyes
- Photography chemicals
- Oil and oil filters
- Cell phones



These items are NOT accepted in the HHW event:



- Explosives
- Ammunition
- Compressed gas cylinders
- Propane tanks (over 5 gal)
- Medical waste
- Narcotics
- Radioactive materials
